### **Course Description**

4 Weeks

#### Understanding of International Relations (IR)

This introductory course covers International Relations theories and methods, providing an overview of international activities, players, and politics at state and local levels. After the course completion, students will understand basic IR theory, enabling them to analyze, critique, and apply theories while exploring its relevance in global politics.

#### Sports SCUBA diving and Understanding the Aquatic Environment

This course covers theories and practical skills of skin diving and scuba diving. Students will learn to explore oceanic environments and ecosystems through lectures (1st week) and hands-on training in basic swimming, skin diving, and scuba diving (2nd-3rd week).

#### **Understanding Korean Culture I**

This course helps international students' understanding of Korean culture and customs in depth. Upon completion, students will comprehend key cultural features of Korea and compare its similarities and differences with their own cultures.



### Sailing yacht(Water Sports)

This course provides fundamental concepts of sailing, including knots, boats, and yacht parts. It also covers the theory and history of sailing, with lectures in the 1st week and practical training in the following weeks (2nd-3rd week).

#### 2 Weeks

#### Korean Language

This is an elementary Korean language course designed for those who have no prior (or very limited) knowledge in Korean. The course goal is to provide a basic foundation that will enable students to acquire and develop language skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing in Korean. Throughout the process of learning these skills, emphasis will be on the student's ability to perform in real-life situations through task-based practice.

- $\circ$  Make sure program fees are transferred under the name of the participant.
- Students are responsible for paying a remittance charge.
  - (On the certificate of tuition payment, it should be noticed correctly of final amount.)  $\rightarrow$  If you don't pay in full, you have to pay extra payment when you come to korea.
- $\circ~$  If payment is made later May 10, the application will not be accepted.
- Please make sure the fees are transferred under the name of the participant.

# Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is not covered by the program fees. The purchase of travel insurance prior to departure to Korea that is valid for the entire duration of travel is the responsibility of each participant and is strongly recommended.

# **Cancellation Policy**

In the event of cancellation, the participants must notify the Office of International Affairs(OIA) in writing.

- For any cancellation before the program starts, a full payment will be refunded but a transfer charge will be deducted from your payment.

# Visa requirement

It is the participant's own responsibility to check with their country and embassy if visa is required to enter Korea. Participants who need a visa will have to make their own arrangements in applying for the visa prior to their arrival here in Korea. Once we received the payment, we will gladly send you a Letter of Acceptance(LoA).
